

Perry Township Supervisors
Meeting Minutes
March 11, 2025

Call to order at 3:00 pm. by Chairman Ronald Howard followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Frank Basile and Tom Brookover with secretary Chris Jarrell.

Public in Attendance: Chuck Obrad, Dave Reese, Mark Kesner and Vicki Lawson

Bid Opening for Fuel and Stone. Only one bid was received for stone from Greer. Total bid was \$85,450.00. A motion was made by Tom Brookover seconded by Frank Basile to accept Greer's bid. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

2 bids were received for fuel: Stuck Enterprises and Bruceton Petroleum. The bid from Bruceton was \$2.59/gallon for a total of \$18,163.60. Stuck Enterprises placed a bid of \$2.26 for a total of \$15,820.00. A motion was made by Frank Basile seconded by Tom Brookover to approve Stuck Enterprises. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Public Comments: (all comments are limited to no more than 5 minutes per person; persons requested to be on the agenda will be recognized first). Mt. Morris Community Center: Vicki Lawson addressed Ron Howard and Tom Brookover asking why they do not stop at the Community Center for events or to offer help. Ron Howard stated he is working on roads. They are busy and do not usually attend community events. Mark Kesner stated the back door at the Center has a broken lock – it will not latch. Frank Basile stated he had already looked at the door and contacted a company for a quote on replacing the door.

Old Business: After reviewing the Elections records, Warren Bowers was elected by write in votes in the 2023 Election. The Township agreed he had write in votes for the term 2024 through 2030. Motion by Tom Brookover second by Frank Basile to add this to the official minutes. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Motion is needed to approve minutes of the February 11, 2025 meeting. Motion by Frank Basile seconded by Tom Brookover. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

A motion is needed to approve the Treasurers report and pay the bills: General Fund & Special funds: \$57,078.22. Payroll: \$27,313.20. Motion made by Tom Brookover seconded by Frank Basile. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Code Enforcement Report was read. Motion to accept by Frank Basile second by Tom Brookover. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to advertise mowing for the 2025 season by Tom Brookover second by Frank Basile. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to approve Heavy Haul presented by DeNoon Lumber for .7 miles of Stevens Road and .3 miles of Wades Run. Fees and bonds are in order. Motion to approve by Frank Basile second by Tom Brookover. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Greene County Department of Recreation has requested donations to fund the annual Day Camp program for County youth. They are requesting \$250.00. Motion by Frank Basile to donate \$100.00 second by Tom Brookover. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion regarding blacktopping Dunkard Avenue. Frank Basile explained he has contacted Russell Standard. They gave preliminary price quotes and broke Dunkard Ave into 3 sections. Section 1 is the small section to the right of Big Shannon (toward Wades), Section 2 is the middle section that runs below Perry School and Section 3 would be the lower creek road that leads to the sewage plant. After discussion of the road being in disrepair and several culverts that need replaced on Dunkard, a motion was made by Frank Basile second by Tom Brookover to put out a bid for Sections 1&2. Depending on the cost, hopefully we can complete section 1&2 this year and work towards Section 3. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to accept EQT annual Heavy Haul renewal for Foley pad on Van Druff/Ridge road. Motion by Tom Brookover second by Frank Basile . Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Street Sweeping. Chuck Obrad questioned if the sweeping would be done this year. Frank Basile stated he has been trying to find a sweeper. He has tentatively scheduled Ten Mile Paving for April 28&29. Mr. Obrad stated the company that the City of Morgantown used may be an option and he will provide us with a phone number.

A new streetlight has been requested to be installed at the corner of Linden and Euclid Avenue. Motion by Tom Brookover second by Frank Basile. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Tom Brookover at 3:29 pm second by Frank Basile. Vote: Motion carried unanimously.
