

Perry Township Minutes  
May 13, 2025

Call to order at 3:00 pm. by Chairman Ronald Howard followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Frank Basile and Tom Brookover with secretary Chris Jarrell.

Public in Attendance: Dave Reese and Chuck Obrad.

Public Comments: Dave Reese inquired as to the open drain on Wades Run. Chairman Howard explained that is a State Road but we are working with them. They are scheduled to blacktop that road and we will work together to install new drains – hopefully a box drain.

Mr. Reese raised the subject of the Legion field and pavilion. In regards to selling/donating to the Legion, Chairman Howard reported the Legion has not contacted him again. Mr. Reese asked about renting the pavilion but was informed it has been vandalized: graffiti, stolen/broken lights. Chairman Howard agreed that it is the property and responsibility of the Township but sees no sense in repairing/maintaining if people are just going to damage it again. Mr. Reese suggested putting cameras up. Supervisor Basile stated that the drainage issue would have been remedied as part of the walking track grant but the grant was returned. Mr. Reese asked if the Township mowed the field but Chairman Howard explained the employees used to but residents didn't feel that was "road work" so the legion field and senior center are paid to be maintained.

Chuck Obrad thanked the board for installing new signs by his home.

New Business:

Code Enforcement Officer Report. Report was read and stands accepted.

Resolution 4-2025. Creation of Light Duty specifications. Light Duty may be offered to an employee after a major medical/surgical event. The employee may temporarily not operate any equipment requiring a CDL but will maintain their job position and salary while performing light duty. Light duty must be applied for prior to returning to work and must be approved by

all 3 Supervisors. A motion to approve Resolution 4-2025 by Tom Brookover second by Frank Basile. Vote: All in favor.

Kuhns Logging has applied for a heavy haul for 1 mile of Brooks Hollow, .1 mile of Kiger Hill and .4 mile of Wades Run Road. Application is complete, all fees paid. Motion to approve by Frank Basile second by Tom Brookover. Vote: All in favor.

Donald Patterson Lot split has been presented by Logan & Gatten Law. The property is on Big Shannon Run. All paperwork is in order. Motion to approve said lot split by Tom Brookover second by Frank Basile. Vote: All in favor.

Motion to adjourn by Tom Brookover at 3:19 pm second by Frank Basile. Vote: All in favor.
