Call to order at 3:00 pm. by Chairman Ronald Howard followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Frank Basile and Tom Brookover with secretary Chris Jarrell.

Public in Attendance: Vicki Lawson, Mark Kesner, Dave Reese, DJ Reese and Bonnie Fox.

Public Comments: (all comments are limited to no more than 5 minutes per person; persons requested to be on the agenda will be recognized first). Mark Kesner has requested to address the board on several subjects regarding the Community Center. First Mr. Kesner wanted to thank the Township and his volunteers for the help at the Center. He advised that Patton Electric will be installing new outlets in the kitchen to handle the various needs such as crockpots and roasters. The Center is paying for this improvement. Mr. Kesner spoke with Commissioner Rohanna regarding applying for a grant for some outdoor upgrades such as outdoor electric receptacles, water spigot and a new flag pole. Mr. Kesner will prepare a Grant application. Vicki Lawson stated they have asked the workers for J&A Landscape not to park their trucks in the parking lot on Wednesdays – perhaps the Township can mention that to them as well. The Center board has concerns about the mowing at the Center. The grass is too high, not trimmed and they do not clean the sidewalks. The Supervisors will speak with Mr. Anderson to discuss.
