

Greene County Fair Board Meeting Minutes

Monday, May 18, 2026

Carol Adamson called meeting to order promptly at 6:30 pm.

New Business:

Wrestling show for 2026 Fair:

- Kevin Jacobs provided some information on a wrestling show as well as Courtney Hursey. In comparison they are similar in price. They both have a following and will promote attendance to the fair.

- We will likely provide premium seating at ringside for an extra cost. We will need to make sure this is monitored.
- Bell will be at 7:00pm and last 2 hours.
 - If they don't use the ring boarder, they will be financially responsible.
 - Wood will be used to stabilize the ring; a tent will be set up for their use near the ring.
 - We may need to have lighting on standby

*Betsy McClure motioned to use Ryse Strong Hold for \$3500.00, Tammy Brookover 2nd, 4 in favor and 3 abstained, motion carried.

Parking: Scott Hackenburg, Board Member and George Scull, community attendee – handed in parking maps.

- Scott made extra suggestions – would like to designate parking for the Horse Trailers and Tractor Trailers on Rodeo and Truck Pull events.
 - Would like to have an earlier arrival
 - Needs people to volunteer that will say no, willing to train and learn a parking pattern
 - Would like to have vender give us some idea of who is arriving so we can designate parking accordingly.
- Parking needs to keep safety in mind, and eventually adjust entry for easier utilization.
 - Need to look into the dirt and gravel for roads, and apply to the county facility in control of it.
- Fair parking –
 - Have handicap riders pay when they board the bus to free up the congestion when entering at the gate, may also consider letting them be brought in through another gate.
 - If use the west gate we would have to make sure to have traffic control, and try to have the police assist with the highway parking. May be able to use as an exit.
 - May look into a traffic control company for future use.
 - East gate may be utilized for trailers (and handicap van entry from pool)
 - The Elm st entrance is very secluded and would need repairs to make useable, even just for staff.
- In the future we may look into making an agreement with Franklin township to utilize the soccer fields on Jefferson/Waynesburg Road and provide a shuttle. It would need an attendant and another bus.
 - Wo would have to create more incentive to generate higher attendance to pay for the shuttle
- The tunnels need remeasured – will revisit at the next meeting
