July 14, 2026

Call to order at 3:00 pm. by Chairman Frank Basile followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present Ronald Howard and Tom Brookover with Secretary Chris Jarrell.

Public in Attendance: Dave Reese, DJ Reese, Chuck Obrad and Officer Gahagen.

Bid Opening, LSA grant to install new boiler at the Mt. Morris Fire Department. Opening and discussion: No bids received.

Public Comments: (all comments are limited to no more than 5 minutes per person; persons requested to be on the agenda will be recognized first). Chuck Obrad questioned the bridge work on Little Shannon. EQT is doing some repairs to the bridge prior to increasing truck traffic to well sites.

New Business:

Greene Washington Regional Police report. Officer Gahagen presented a monthly report. No questions were asked.

Motion is needed to approve minutes of the June 9, 2026 meeting. Motion by Tom Brookover seconded by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

A motion is needed to approve the Treasurers report and pay the bills: General Fund & Special funds: \$52,063.79. Payroll: \$39,212.19. Motion made by Tom Brookover seconded by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

Code Enforcement Report is attached.

Tim Neil, SEO presented application for sewage for the Foley South pad on Ridge Road. Tim approved the permit. EQT owns the reclaimed Liberty Vantage well site and there is still an open bond on that site. EQT requested to transfer the bond to the Foley South site. Motion to approve by Tom Brookover second by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

McMillen Engineering presented a Resolution 2-2026 to apply for a Multi-Modal Grant through the Commonwealth Financing Authority to replace a culvert on Lemley Hill Road. Motion by Ronald Howard second by Tom Brookover to approve the Resolution. Vote: All in favor.

2 applications were presented by Boord Bencheck and Associates for pull offs for well trucks. One pull off on Little Shannon Run and one on Haines Hill. Application, maps and payment is complete. Motion to approve the 2 pull-offs by Tom Brookover second by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

EQT presented a Heavy Haul application for Church Run Road, Little Shannon and Stevens Road. Application is pending approval upon receipt of bond and checks. Motion to grant conditional approval on the Heavy Haul application by Tom Brookover second by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

EQT presented open/cut applications for Church Run and Little Shannon. Motion to grant conditional approval on the open/cut applications once checks for \$800.00 (4x\$200) are received by Tom Brookover second by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

EQT presented paperwork for 13 temporary driveways. Paperwork is complete. 8 driveways on Little Shannon Run, 1 on Hacklebender, 3 on Church Run and 1 on Stevens Road. Motion to grant conditional approval on the temporary driveway permits once checks are received (13 x \$200= \$2600) by Ronald Howard second by Tom Brookover. Vote: All in favor.

Heavy Haul renewal received from Monongalia County Coal for .64 miles of Wilson Road. Motion to approve continuation for Mon County Coal by Tom Brookover second by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.

Motion to adjourn by Tom Brookover at 3:09pm second by Ronald Howard. Vote: All in favor.
